Emanuela Loi was born in Cagliari in October 1967.

She is remembered for having been killed with the judge Borsellino and four other colleagues in the attack in D'Amelio Street on 19th July 1992.

That day she became the first policewoman who died in service because of mafia.

She was born and grew up in Sardinia. She wanted to be a teacher but at the age of twenty she joined the police and after a short time she was entrusted to the Palermo police station. She had important assignments as the posting to the mafia boss Francesco Madonia.

After the Capaci attempt in which the judge Falcone lost his life, she was assigned to the judge Borsellino's safety escort.

Her sister Claudia keeps her memory alive in schools, thanks also to the anti-mafia Libera association that fights against mafia crimes.
