Enrico Calamai

Enrico Calamai was born on 24th june 1945 in Rome. He's an Italian diplomatic and he was call 'The Schindler of Buenos Aires' because he saved over three — hundred persecuted people from the Argentine military regime. Some people survived had document what he did. Calamai always said that it wasn't him, but someone like him.

BIOGRAPHY

After his Economic studies, he started a diplomatic career and he served in Spain and Italy.

In 1972, he went in Buenos Aires as Italian vice - consul. After a year he went in Chile for a mission. In it he saved 412 refugees and he transported them in Italy; 50 of them were kids.

In 1976 Calamai went in Buenos Aires again and, with the help of the journalist Giangiacomo Foà and the syndacalist Filippo di Benedetto, managed to put over 100 political opponents. In fact, when he was in the Argentin military dictatorship, most of the dead died in horrible ways: somebody pushed them out of an airplane and they fell into the amazon river.

In the Friday 3rd May 2019 he received the honorary citizenship of Giaveno
